Being a woman of action, and using the power of long-cultivated and respected connections, she immediately worked with Nancy Stager at Eastern Bank, and the Antigua and Barbuda Red Cross, to set up a system for donations to the Antigua & Barbuda Hurricane Relief fund. She wrote:

"Seeing all the devastation of Hurricanes Harvey, Irma and now developing Jose should give us all cause to pause and reflect on how meaningless the material things that we lose sleep over, fight over, lose friendship over are not really worth it. Today let us go out and love more, smile more, help more and make peace with each other instead of fighting over temporal possessions that could be gone in a matter of minutes..."

She has been a force in uniting Boston's professionals. This year, Collette was honored by The Jewish Alliance for Law and Social Action with their Advocate for Justice award. After creating **Kaleidoscope**, Boston's first comprehensive multicultural resource guide, she launched **Get Connected!** to bring together urban and international professionals, business executives, and entrepreneurs from various cultures. **Get Connected!** has forged new business and social relationships, making Boston a more diverse and inclusive city.

Our awardee is a graduate of Emerson College where she received a Bachelor of Science, summa cum laude, and a Master of Science degree. Hear her share her life lessons and professional wisdom on the 28th.
