She is a lecturer at the Northeastern University College of Professional Studies.

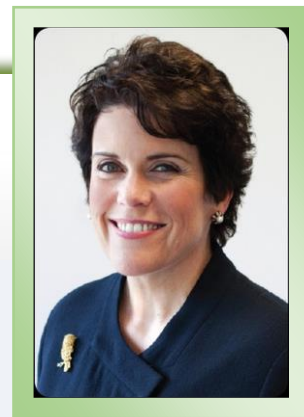
This program is especially important for our 40+ professional communicators. Plus, those of us who know we must – but haven't yet – updated our skills and revamped our presentation - and attitude.

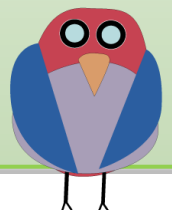
