MBTA Directions from South Station

1. Take the MBTA Silver Line SL1 or SL2 route to World Trade Center Station
2. Exit at the World Trade Center Station
3. Go up to the top level, following the signs for the Boston Convention and Exhibition Center
4. Head southwest on World Trade Center Ave toward Summer Street
5. Turn left onto Summer Street
6. Turn right onto D Street
7. Turn left onto Fargo Street
8. We are located at 70 Fargo Street
